## VOLKER BROMMANN

Volker Brommann was born in Northern Germany, where he apprenticed in the German Equestrian Federation training program with Walter Christensen, and went on to become a licensed Bereiter, and a Pferdewirtschaftsmeister. On the advice, and remaining under the tutelage of Christensen, he originally moved to Massachusetts in 1981 to be head trainer at Priscilla Endicott's stables (author of "Taking Up the Reins").

Volker has worked closely over the years with Klaus Balkenhol (former coach of the German and the U.S. Dressage Team and Olympic medalist). He has recently trained with Andreas Hausberger of (Chief Rider at the Spanish Riding School), Conrad Schumacher, and currently with Johann Hinnemann.
